The Service

- Primary care with integrated case management for marginalized communities in Terrace
- Services are currently offered from a mobile clinic at local shelters, supported living complexes and encampments, as well as a Stationary Clinic
- Operating in strong collaboration with community and health authority partners

The Outreach Team

The outreach team delivers care through various models to reach people where they're at — seeing patients out of the mobile clinic, partner sites, and the stationary clinic, with offset schedules to ensure at least two staff at service delivery points, 6 days per week. The team includes the following members:

- Clinical Director
- Clinic Manager
- Physicians
- Nurses
- Social Workers
- Mental Health and Substance Use Clinicians
- Cultural Navigators
- Peer Support Workers

Physician Roles & Schedule

- Deliver low-barrier primary care to individuals who rarely access primary care
- Help improve community health outcomes and reduce ER congestion
- Operating hours: 10:00 am – 6:00 pm, 6 days/week
- Flexible schedule options: Full days, half-days, or casual coverage; weekdays or weekends
- Adequate time for comprehensive visits, including protected administrative time
- Supported by the multidisciplinary team
- No follow-up required when not on shift

Compensation

- Alternative Payment Plan (APP) contract; no FFS; no overhead
- Hourly rate: \$266.33
- Daily rate (8 hrs): \$2,130.64
- Travel and accommodation covered
